

# Toorak

## Nearby:

Hawksburn Village (900 metres, 10-15 minute walk, Map): Woolworths supermarket, Post Office, Cafes, Restaurants, Pub, McDonalds, Subway, Retail stores, ATM

Toorak Village (1km, 10-15 minute walk, Map): Woolworths supermarket, Post Office, Cafes, Restaurants, Retail stores, Banks (Westpac, Bank of Melbourne, Commonwealth, ANZ), ATMs

Chapel St (2km, 20-30 minute walk, tram ride, Map): Coles and Woolworths supermarket, Jam Factory Village Cinema, Banks, ATMs Rebel Sport, Cafes, Restaurants, lots of retail stores

Prahran Market (2km, 20-20 minute walk, tram ride, Map): Fresh produce (meats, fruits, vegetables, fish etc)

7-Eleven Convenience Store (250m 3 minute walk Map)

## Public Transport:

You need a Myki Card to travel on public transport. Buy one at 7-Eleven stores (Closest 250m 3 minute walk Map).

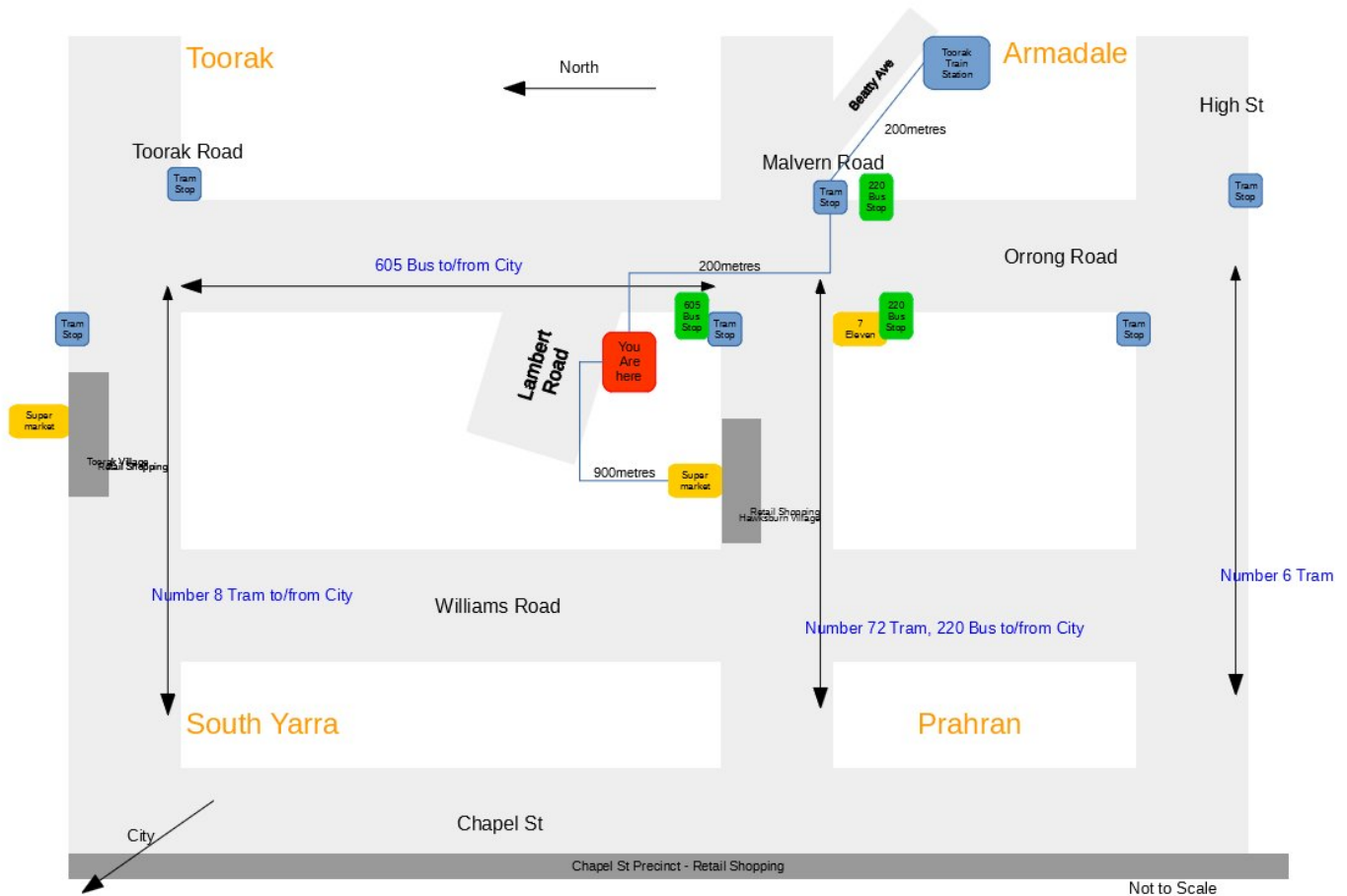
We are located

- 200 metres (3 minute walk) to the Route 72 Tram (Map) to/from the city
- 200 metres (3 minute walk) to the Route 220 bus (Map) to/from the city
- 150 metres (2 minute walk) to the Route 605 bus (Map) to/from the city
- 450 metres (6 minute walk) to the Toorak Railway Station (Map) which is 4 stops and 11 minutes to/from the city with trains typically running every 10 minutes.

## Getting Here

### From the Airport

#### By Bus, Then Train

Catch the Sky Bus to Southern Cross Station. This takes about 20 minutes. You'll need to buy a bus ticket at the airport. Once you arrive at Southern Cross, go upstairs to catch a train to Toorak Station. You will need to purchase a Myki card from either a 7-11 store or from the ticket booth upstairs. Normally trains for Toorak depart from Platform 12 but this can change depending on the time of day - always check the screens on the platform to be sure or ask a uniformed staff member. Depending on the time of day, trains to Toorak Station take 16-19 minutes.

Once you arrive at Toorak Station, go up the ramp, turn left and exit the station by

turning left into Beatty Ave (you should be by the shops). Walk straight down there for about 200 metres following the train line towards the city. Once you reach the intersection at Malvern and Orrong Roads, use the pedestrian crossing at the traffic lights, twice, to reach the diagonally opposite corner of the intersection. Walk down the hill (50 metres) and you are almost there.

Total Time: approx 40-50 minutes

Total Cost: approx \$18 per person one way for Sky Bus and \$4 per person for the Myki ticket

## **By Taxi**

Catch a taxi from the taxi rank outside the terminal and give the taxi driver the address.

Total Time: approx 30-45 minutes but potentially longer in busy times.

Total Cost: approx \$90-110 per taxi

## **From the City**

### **By Taxi**

Catch a taxi from the many taxi ranks in the city and give the taxi driver the address.

Total Time: approx 20-25 minutes but potentially much longer in busy times.

Total Cost: approx \$25 per taxi

### **By Train**

From any of the city train stations, catch a train to Toorak. You will need to purchase a Myki card from either a 7-11 store or from a ticket booth. Typically you will be looking for trains on one of the following lines: Franston, Cranbourne, Pakenham, or Dandenong. Always check the screens to on the platform to be sure that the train goes to Toorak or ask a uniformed staff member. Depending on the time of day, and which station you depart from trains to Toorak Station take 11-19 minutes.

Once you arrive at Toorak Station, go up the ramp, turn left and exit the station by turning left into Beatty Ave (you should be by the shops). Walk straight down there for about 200 metres following the train line towards the city. Once you reach the intersection at Malvern and Orrong Roads, use the pedestrian crossing at the traffic lights, twice, to reach the diagonally opposite corner of the intersection. Walk down the hill (50 metres) and you are almost there.

Total Time: approx 11-19 minutes

Total Cost: \$4 per person for the Myki ticket

## **By Tram**

If you are on Swanston St right in the centre of the City you can catch the number 72 and get off the tram at the corner of Malvern and Orrong Roads. You can always ask the driver if you are unsure of where to get off the tram.

Total Time: approx 20-25 minutes
